

Fly Pan Pacific

FLY the CHINA CLIPPER for a civilized journey to the romance of the East....

FLIGHTS leave San Francisco on a fortnightly basis, passengers boarding the new Boeing Clipper at noon for an eleven hour flight to Hawaii. In luxuriously appointed cabins full steward service is provided, complete with first class meals and comfortable sleeping berths. After arriving in the Hawaiian Islands, passengers can select one of a number of first class hotels in which to spend the second night of their journey. Honolulu offers a variety of nightlife, and travellers may well choose to pause here for a while to enjoy the varied delights of this most westerly part of the United States.

The Clipper departs at 10:00 am on the morning after its arrival and after a few hours flying time, arrives in the French mandate of the MARIVELLAS, a group of islands heavily influenced by the colonial government, but still possessing a distinct charm all their own.

After a brief stop at the island capital of TAGATAYA, the flight pauses overnight on the island of BORAGORA; an idyllic paradise retreat set in the sapphire of the Pacific ocean. Its first class hotel, brimming with Romance and Character, possesses an atmosphere that could be classed as unique.

The Monkey Bar, renowned for the intriguing carvings that swarm over the interior bar, serves an excellent cuisine. Local specialities include shark in mornay sauce, Pacific oysters, flying fish a la francais, and any number of exotic fruit and vegetables.

Its owner is also currently the local Magistrate de Justice and is empowered to perform marriages, as well as cater for your legal requirements during your stay.

During your time on the island you can take advantage of many of its local facilities. The hotel will happily hire you a horse should you wish, while any number of boats are available for charter. For the truly adventurous, it is possible to charter a small seaplane, whose pilot will be willing to take you on a tour of the islands.

Rooms are available in the hotel from 15 francs a night, and the Clipper makes regular weekly stops - east one week, west the next, while it is possible to travel on from here on a number of sea routes.

The Clipper departs BORAGORA for SHANGHAI and HONG KONG, from where the traveller can choose any number of exotic places to visit, including SINGAPORE, SAIGON, and MACAU. PAN PACIFIC will be pleased to advise the would-be passenger on potential destinations, and can book tickets right through to INDIA and beyond.

Return flights depart from SHANGHAI on alternate weeks, pausing at BORAGORA and HONOLULU, before landing at SAN FRANCISCO after a journey of four days.

Places are limited, so book early to avoid disappointment. Tickets are available to any destination on the route, and travellers are advised to reserve their return seats from the appropriate departure point.
